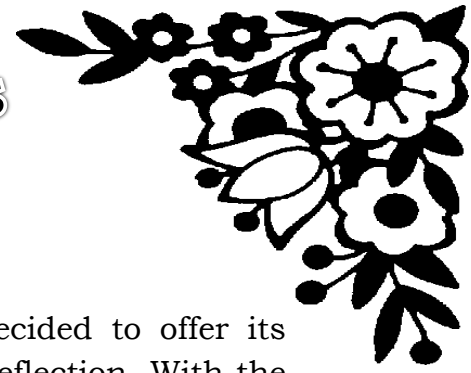




# Prayer Spaces
