To make it better

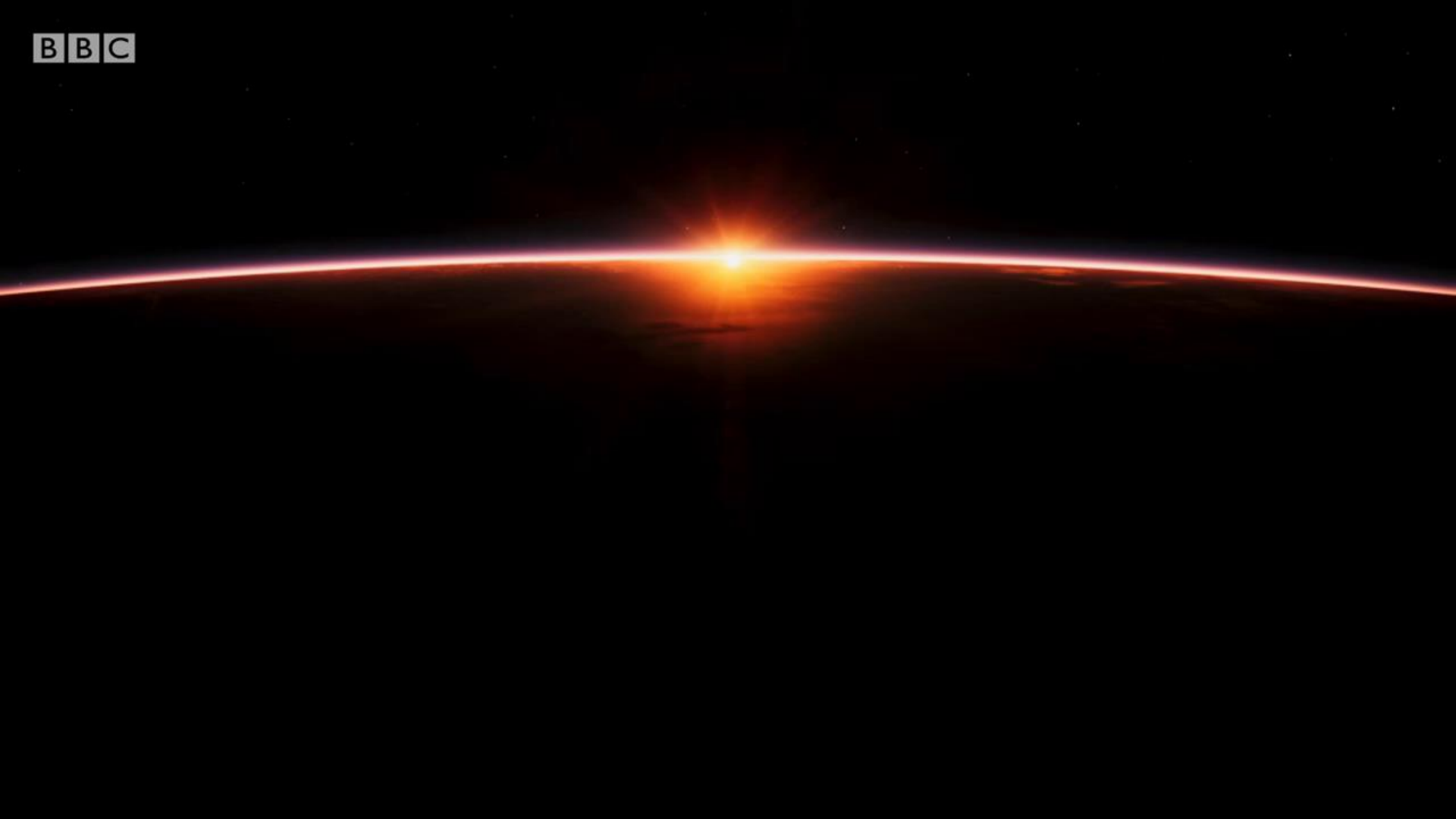

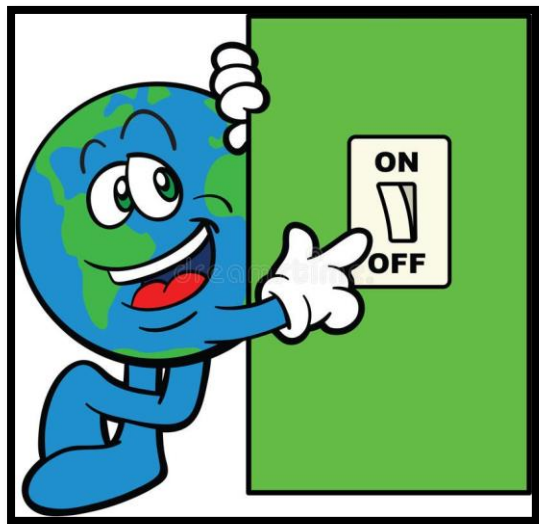
